Officer and Director Reports:

- Philadelphia Soccer 2026 Initiative
 - The 501(c)(3) organization serves as the governing body for the World Cup in Philadelphia.

 26 for 26 Challenge: Encourage 26 donors to contribute \$26 for a chance to win Union tickets.

• US Soccer Registration (Calendar Year vs. School Year)

- Push to increase registrations.
- SVSL will adopt the registration format mandated by the state.
- High likelihood of shifting to a school-year registration model.

Growing Demand for U8 Travel

- EPYSA is considering adopting a U8 travel program.
- Discussion on forming an SVSL U8 travel team to play a year up if there is sufficient demand.

Policy 531-9: Misconduct Toward Officials

- Notable reduction in referee incidents.
- Stricter penalties now in place, including suspensions ranging from a three-game ban to lifetime suspension if a referee is physically touched.

• Grant Applications

- EPYSA grants available.
- SVSL needs to demonstrate club growth to qualify.

Registrar Report (Robin Kelchner):

• Spring Registration Numbers:

- 10 Little Panthers registered (10 incomplete).
- 31 Intramural players (3 incomplete).
- 24 Recreational players (10 incomplete).
- Age Group Breakdown:
 - 5 players (2014)
 - 10 players (2015)
 - 2 players (2016)

• 6 players (2017)

• Key Registration Notes:

- Some Rec coaches were unaware that players must register separately for each season.
- Rec rosters due soon. There will be coach follow up. (See action items)
- **Registration Closing Date:** February 20, 2025.

• Team Commitments (Due March 6, 2025):

- U12 & U13 Girls:
 - 14 players on U13 roster not fully committed.
 - U13 wants to merge with U12, but this would create a 26-player roster (max roster size: 22, with 18 able to suit up). Potentially will move to Blue Mountain. (See Action Items)

Fundraising & Events Report (Denise O'Connell):

- Discussions with McDonald's for an end-of-August or early September event.
- New logo in progress for Spring Spirit Wear Sale (Board will vote on final design).
- Planning fall sponsorship outreach.
- Possible Spring/Summer event ideas: Soccer Golf, Dine-to-Donate, large-scale community event.
- Gambling license renewal due August 23 (\$125 renewal fee).
- Exploring EPYSA grant programs.

Finance Report (Paul Stewart):

• TeamSnap Usage and Budget Overview:

- Reviewing discretionary budget.
- No significant financial concerns at present.
- Will reassess budget for Little Panthers, Intramural, and Rec programs to identify gaps or funding needs.

• Treasurer Vacancy & Succession Planning:

• The board needs to recruit a new Treasurer and establish a succession plan.

Coaching Director Report (Nicole Spirk):

- Communicating with coaches regarding practice schedules starting in March.
- Reinhardt confirmed for Little Panthers and Intramural games.

• Boys Coaching Concern:

• Community concerns raised about a former coach.

Field Maintenance:

- Over 20 trees removed; borough to be notified if additional trees need removal.
- Seeding and Aeration at Grist Mill:
 - Motion to seed Grist Mill with 5-6 bags of seed at \$85 per bag.
 - Motion passes 6-0.

NEW BUSINESS:

- Evaluations: Communication and Planning
- **Player Retention:** Discussion on coaches requesting to add players for spring who were not on fall rosters.
- **Teams in Focus:** Ensuring teams with poor fall experiences receive adequate support in spring (2013 Girls Travel, 2015 Boys Travel, 2017 Boys).

- **Open Support Positions:** Equipment Director & Treasurer.
